



CALIFORNIA STATE LIBRARY WIRELESS INTERNET USE POLICY

The California State Library (CSL) provides free wireless access to the Internet. Wireless users must agree to abide by State Library Rules and the Library's Internet Policy.

The California State Library's wireless connection is not secure. Cautious and informed wireless users should choose not to transmit confidential information (credit card numbers, passwords and any other sensitive information) while using any wireless "hot spot." Please take appropriate precautions when using this service.

Visitors using the CSL wireless network are expected to demonstrate judgment, respect for others and appropriate conduct while using library resources and facilities.

Wireless Internet Prohibited Uses

- Viewing, distributing, or displaying visual depictions that are obscene, harmful to minors, or constitute child pornography
- Misrepresenting oneself, for fraudulent or illegal purposes, as another user
- Attempts to modify, disrupt or gain access to files, passwords, or data belonging to others
- Seeking unauthorized access to any computer system
- Making unauthorized copies of copyrighted or licensed material in any form
- Violating any federal, state, local or library laws or regulations

Failure to comply with the CSL Policies may warrant withdrawal of Internet access privileges and possible exclusion from CSL.
