Funding Comments

Given the difficult budget situation this year, we are unable to make firm commitments for LSTA funded projects at this time. We would like you to proceed ahead with the paperwork so we can proceed as soon as the State budget is passed. Thank you for your patience.

Program Goal

The goal of this program is to support the development of professional librarians by providing library staff with tuition reimbursement for their library school studies.

How the Program Works

Employees of public and county law libraries can apply for tuition reimbursement for their graduate coursework toward an MLIS degree at an ALA-accredited library school. The program is competitive so not every applicant is selected to receive funding.

To apply, eligible individuals need to complete the *New Student Application* and submit it to their local Cooperative Library System.

All applicants will be notified if they were selected, or not selected, to receive reimbursement funding by the Cooperative Library System.

If selected to receiving reimbursement funding, the applicant must pay for the courses, complete the course, then provide proof of the fee paid, and a copy of the grade received in the course to the Cooperative Library System which will issue the reimbursement to the student.

What the Program Pays For

Individuals can receive reimbursement for library school course fees not to exceed \$5,000 per grant year after they have successfully completed at least one full year of employment at their library. No individual shall receive reimbursement for more than five grant years under this program.

Only courses where the individual received a grade of B- or better are eligible for reimbursement.

Students who are receiving course reimbursement from an IMLS Laura Bush 21st Century Librarian grant can only receive PLSEP reimbursement for those courses not previously reimbursed from the Laura Bush grant.

What the Program Does Not Pay For

Books, student union and association fees, health fees, transcript fees, and parking are not reimbursed under this program.

Time Table

June 30, 2015	All requests for tuition reimbursement must be submitted to the Cooperative Library System contact person prior to this date.

Responsibilities of Students Selected to Receive Reimbursement

- Provide receipts and proof of grade received in courses to the Cooperative Library System contact person in a timely manner.
- Track the amount of reimbursements requested during the grant year in relation to your total grant award.
- Complete and provide your Student Final Program Narrative Report to the Cooperative Library System contact person no later than **July 30, 2015**.

Instructions for Completing the Application

Please be sure to follow all the instructions or else your application will be disqualified.

Item	Notes
1.	Fill in the name of the library where you are employed, not the branch name. For example, fill in the Sacramento Public Library, not the Natomas Branch.
2.	Fill in your full legal name, phone number, email address, and employment date.
3.	Fill in your library’s local Cooperative Library System. See page 5 for a list of libraries and Cooperative Library Systems.
4.	List the library school through which you will be studying for your MLIS degree.
5.	Enter the reimbursement amount you are requesting.
6.	List the library courses for which you will be seeking reimbursement. The information you provide on the number of courses and units to be completed must be as accurate and realistic as possible. List only Summer 2014, Fall 2014, Winter 2015 and/or Spring 2015.
7.	Based upon the number of courses you plan to take per academic session, please list the estimated semester/quarter and year you hope to graduate from library school.
8.	Tell us in an essay your interest and commitment to public library work. . Be sure to tell us why public library work is important to you and why you are interested in going to library school. (Limit to one page using 12 point font).
9.	<p>Request and attach 2-3 recommendation letters to your application. Recommendation letters will only be accepted from the following individuals:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Former or current supervisor or employer. • Former instructor from whom you have taken a course in the past 5 years. • Volunteer or professional organization/association leader or officer with whom you have worked. <p>The recommendation letters must include the following information:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How long and in what connection has the individual known the applicant? • Why does the individual feel the applicant would be an asset to public library service? <p>Each letter should specifically address the applicant’s communication/interpersonal skills, creativity, initiative, leadership and judgment abilities, and include the date and full contact information for the writer. Please attach your recommendation letters directly after your essay.</p>
10.	List education and courses completed, work related experience, and community/volunteer experience in the space provided.

11.	List any of the following special skills or abilities and indicate any experience in utilizing these skills: bilingual or multilingual language skills, children's services, young adult services, and/or knowledge of library technology
12.	List training sessions, workshops, or courses attended in the last five years along with titles, sponsors and date/year of attendance in the space provided.
13.	Review and sign your application.
14.	Have your library director or their designee sign your application verifying employment.

Submission Instructions

Provide original plus six (6) copies of your application to the designated contact person at the Cooperative Library System no later than **Tuesday, April 1, 2014** for submission to the State Library.

Incomplete applications, or student applications submitted directly to the State Library will be disqualified.
