



Highlights


Population Growth: The total population in Calaveras County grew by 12% over the past decade to 46,000. Large gains occurred in the white, non-Hispanic population, which grew by 3,000 people, and the Hispanic population, which grew by 2,000 people.

Diversity: Calaveras County is predominantly white, non-Hispanic, though this share decreased from 87% to 84% of total over the past ten years. Meanwhile, the Hispanic share increased from 7% to 10%.

Age structure: The population of Calaveras County is much older than the state overall, with a median age of 49 compared with 35 statewide. The shift toward older age brackets continued over the past ten years as the age 65+ share of total increased from 18% to 21%, compared with 11% statewide, and the share of young people decreased from 25% to 22%, compared with 28% in California overall.

Households: Families without children are more common in Calaveras County—47% here, compared with 36% statewide. Also, older people are more likely to be living with a spouse—28% in Calaveras County compared with 21% statewide.

Education: Calaveras County has a smaller share of adults who have not completed high school—11% compared with 20% statewide. Conversely, a smaller share of adults have earned a Bachelor’s degree or higher—19% compared with 30% in California overall.





In thousands; males on left, females on right




2. Race and Ethnicity by Library-Defined Age Group, 2010




3. Population Growth by Library-Defined Age Group, 2000-10




5. 10-Year Population Change








7. 10-Year Change in Population, 2000-10




8. Population by Age, Race, and Ethnicity, 2010




9. Age Mix by Race and Ethnicity, 2010



10. Foreign Born, 2005-09




11. Household Language, 2005-09





12. Household Income, 2005-09



13. Labor Force and Unemployment, 2006-11





14. Household Type, 2010



15. Average Household Size, 2010




16. Living Arrangements Age 65+, 2005-09
