

Highlights



Population Growth: The total population of Blythe increased by 71% over the past decade from 12,000 to 21,000, growing seven times faster than the state. The Hispanic population grew by 5,500 (99%) and the black population grew by 2,000 (211%). Most of the growth occurred in the working-age population.

Diversity: Blythe became majority Hispanic over the past ten years as the Hispanic share of total population increased from 46% to 53%. The black share also increased from 8% to 15%, while the white, non-Hispanic share fell from 42% to 28%.


Age Structure: Over the last ten years, the age structure shifted sharply upward as the working-age population expanded. The working-age population now accounts for 69% of total population, up from just 53% in 2000, and young people make up 22% of the total, down from 37% in 2000. The median age increased from 31 to 38 and now exceeds the statewide median of 35.

Households: The share of family households, 71%, is similar to the state share, but unmarried parents with children are more common in Blythe, accounting for 17% of households, compared with 10% in California overall. The share of married couples with children declined from 27% to 21% of all households over the past decade. Older people are more likely to be living alone—36% here compared with 25% in California overall—and in group homes—10% here compared with 4% statewide.

Education: Educational attainment is lower in Blythe than in California overall. Just 8% of adults have a Bachelor’s degree, compared with 30% statewide, and 28% have not completed high school, compared with 20% in California overall.

Income: Income is relatively low in Blythe. Median household income is \$39,000, just 65% of the California median; 33% of all households have income of less than \$25,000, compared with 20% statewide.

Note: The Palo Verde Valley Library District extends beyond the city limits of Blythe. This profile covers only the population within the city limits.








2. Race and Ethnicity by Library-Defined Age Group, 2010




3. Population Growth by Library-Defined Age Group, 2000-10




5. 10-Year Population Change








7. 10-Year Change in Population, 2000-10




8. Population by Age, Race, and Ethnicity, 2010




9. Age Mix by Race and Ethnicity, 2010




12. Household Income, 2005-09

a) Income Distribution




b) Median Household Income by Race and Ethnicity*




14. Household Type, 2010

a) Total, 2000-10




b) By Race and Ethnicity,* 2010




15. Average Household Size, 2010

By Race and Ethnicity*




16. Living Arrangements Age 65+, 2005-09




