

Highlights



Population Growth: Population in the San Mateo County Library jurisdiction stayed relatively constant between 2000 and 2010, at 267,000. The Asian population increased by 36,000 (25%), and the Hispanic population increased by 28,000 (18%), while the white, non-Hispanic population declined by 49,000 (-14%).

Diversity: The racial and ethnic composition has shifted to some extent over the past decade, with the white, non-Hispanic share of the population decreasing from 59% to 52% of total, the Asian share increasing from 13% to 18%, and the Hispanic share increasing from 20% to 22%.

Age Structure: This jurisdiction is somewhat older than California overall, and the age structure shifted upward slightly over the last ten years. The share of the population age 65+ increased from 12% to 14%, higher than the 11% share statewide. Meanwhile, the numbers of working-age adults and young people declined.


Households: Traditional families—married couples with children—are slightly more common than in California overall, at 26% of all households, compared with 23% statewide.

Education: The population is highly educated, with 48% of adults having earned a Bachelor’s degree or higher, compared with 30% statewide. Just 11% of adults have not completed high school, compared with 20% in California.

Income: Incomes are high in this jurisdiction, with 28% of households reporting income of \$150,000 or higher, compared with 12% of households statewide.

Foreign Born: The foreign-born population accounts for 27% of the total, the same as the share statewide. In contrast with the state, 42% of these individuals are from Asia, compared with 34% of immigrants in California.

Note: The San Mateo County Library jurisdiction includes the county population that is not served by the seven municipal libraries.




Population by Age

In thousands; males on left, females on right




2. Race and Ethnicity by Library-Defined Age Group, 2010




4. Population Total, 1990-2010

5. 10-Year Population Change








7. 10-Year Change in Population, 2000-10




8. Population by Age, Race, and Ethnicity, 2010




9. Age Mix by Race and Ethnicity, 2010

11. Household Language, 2005-09




12. Household Income, 2005-09

a) Income Distribution




b) Median Household Income by Race and Ethnicity*

Unemployment Rate




14. Household Type, 2010

a) Total, 2000-10




b) By Race and Ethnicity,* 2010




15. Average Household Size, 2010

By Race and Ethnicity*




16. Living Arrangements Age 65+, 2005-09




