




Hillsborough is served by the Burlingame Public Library (two-thirds) and by the San Mateo Public Library (one-third). This individual city profile is provided for reference.




Population by Age

In thousands; males on left, females on right




2. Race and Ethnicity by Library-Defined Age Group, 2010




3. Population Growth by Library-Defined Age Group, 2000-10




5. 10-Year Population Change





Males on left, females on right




7. 10-Year Change in Population, 2000-10




8. Population by Age, Race, and Ethnicity, 2010




9. Age Mix by Race and Ethnicity, 2010



10. Foreign Born, 2005-09





11. Household Language, 2005-09


12. Household Income, 2005-09


13. Labor Force and Unemployment, 2006-11




