Greg Lucas Appointed as State Librarian

SACRAMENTO – Governor Edmund G. Brown Jr. today announced the appointment of Greg Lucas as State Librarian. Lucas, 55, has been a senior editor for Capitol Weekly since 2011 and has written and edited California's Capitol, a website he created focusing on California history and politics, since 2007. He was Sacramento bureau chief and a Capitol reporter for the San Francisco Chronicle from 1988 to 2007 and covered the Capitol for the Los Angeles Daily Journal from 1985 to 1988. Lucas has been a board member at the Friends of the California State Archives since 2012. He earned a Master of Arts degree in professional writing from the University of Southern California.
