

## Fall 2017 California Braille & Talking Book Library Survey Results

BTBL's biennial patron survey was conducted through [Survey Monkey](#) from November 2017 through January 2018. The Survey Monkey link was advertised on the [BTBL home page](#), [BTBL Facebook page](#), and in all versions of our newsletter (braille, audio, large-print, and electronic versions). The large-print edition of our Fall 2017 newsletter contained a detachable version of the survey that could be returned by mail. Mailed responses to the survey were manually entered by BTBL staff into Survey Monkey. Patrons also had the option to complete the survey over the phone with the live help of staff. The total number of responses we received was 260, and a detailed breakdown can be found below:
