FACTS ABOUT THE FUNDED PROJECTS

A SUCCESS STORY

45 Public Library buildings with over 1.5 million square-feet were funded.

LOCAL FUNDS REQUIRED

35% local match for a 65% State Grant generated over \$100 million of local funds.

NEW LIBRARIES

About half of the projects are new libraries built where none existed previously.

REPLACE & REMODEL

The other half replace or remodel worn out libraries; the oldest built in 1888.

HOMEWORK CENTERS

Most are joint-use libraries that focus on serving K-12 students with homework centers.

FAMILY LITERACY CENTERS

Many have Literacy Centers that help adults and children learn to read.

CAREER CENTERS

Some have Career Centers to assist job seekers and expand economic development opportunities.

UNIVERSAL ACCESS

All provide access for people with disabilities.




