


Highlights



Population by Age

Population Growth: The population in the County of Los Angeles Public Library jurisdiction increased by 3% over the past decade to 3.3 million—this was slower than the statewide growth rate of 10%. The greatest growth occurred in the Hispanic and Asian populations.

Diversity: This jurisdiction is majority Hispanic, at 56%. Over the past ten years, the white, non-Hispanic population share decreased from 24% to 20%, and the Asian share grew from 12% to 14%.

Age Structure: The age structure shifted upward slightly over the past decade, as the share of young people declined from 34% to 30%, and the working-age population share increased from 57% to 60%.

Households: Family households are more common in this jurisdiction than statewide, at 76% of all households, compared with 69% across California. Only 18% are single-person households, compared with 23% statewide. Further, a smaller share of people age 65+ live alone than statewide—20% compared with 25%.

Education: Educational attainment is lower than in California overall. Just 22% of adults have attained a Bachelor’s degree, compared with 30% of adults statewide, and 28% have not completed high school, compared with 20% statewide.

Foreign Born: The foreign-born population makes up 34% of the total, compared with 27% statewide. The majority of foreign-born individuals are from Mexico (53%). Sixteen percent of households in this area are linguistically isolated, compared with 10% in California overall.


The County of Los Angeles Public Library serves the county population not served by the 33 municipal libraries and the two special district libraries. The county library profile slightly overstates the actual population served because it includes some unincorporated areas that are legally served by other libraries.

In thousands; males on left, females on right




2. Race and Ethnicity by Library-Defined Age Group, 2010




3. Population Growth by Library-Defined Age Group, 2000-10




5. 10-Year Population Change

6. Population by 5-Year Age Brackets



7. 10-Year Change in Population, 2000-10






8. Population by Age, Race, and Ethnicity, 2010




9. Age Mix by Race and Ethnicity, 2010




12. Household Income, 2005-09

a) Income Distribution




b) Median Household Income by Race and Ethnicity*

Labor Force In millions




14. Household Type, 2010

a) Total, 2000-10




b) By Race and Ethnicity,* 2010




15. Average Household Size, 2010

By Race and Ethnicity*




16. Living Arrangements Age 65+, 2005-09




