

Highlights




Population Growth: Population of the Napa City-County Library jurisdiction showed similar growth to the state as a whole, increasing by 10% over the past ten years to a total of 131,000.

Diversity: This jurisdiction is majority white, non-Hispanic, though this share of the population declined over the past decade from 69% to 56%, while the Hispanic share increased from 23% to 32% of total.

Age Structure: The age structure in this jurisdiction did not change substantially between 2000 and 2010, in contrast to statewide aging trends. Though the population age 65+ did increase by 8%, the number of young and working age people grew as well. The share of the total population age 65+ remained constant at 15%, higher than the statewide share of 11%.

Foreign Born: The foreign-born population makes up 21% of the total in the Napa City-County Library jurisdiction, compared with 27% statewide. Mexico is the most common country of origin for the foreign-born population with 64%, compared with 44% statewide.

Note: The Napa City-County Library serves the county population that is not located in St. Helena.





In thousands; males on left, females on right




2. Race and Ethnicity by Library-Defined Age Group, 2010




3. Population Growth by Library-Defined Age Group, 2000-10




5. 10-Year Population Change





In thousands; males on left, females on right




7. 10-Year Change in Population, 2000-10




8. Population by Age, Race, and Ethnicity, 2010




9. Age Mix by Race and Ethnicity, 2010

11. Household Language, 2005-09




12. Household Income, 2005-09

a) Income Distribution




b) Median Household Income by Race and Ethnicity*

Unemployment Rate




14. Household Type, 2010

a) Total, 2000-10




b) By Race and Ethnicity,* 2010




15. Average Household Size, 2010

By Race and Ethnicity*




16. Living Arrangements Age 65+, 2005-09




