Position Overview:

Do you have an eye for talent? The Library is looking for people who do, to join our Talent Scout team in recruiting people with talents, knowledge, or skills they'd like to share. You might find the next America's Idol! And if you don't, you will be helping to shine a light on what (and who) is fabulous in Marin County.

Key Responsibilities:

- Reaching out to other people's worlds.
- Working with people to develop a wide range of programs to present to the Community.
- Assessing what people want to see and vetting program ideas
- Talking with other libraries to discover successful performers/program ideas.
- Preparing publicity for the programs.
- Tracking program success.

Qualifications:

- An eye for potential program presenters.
- A "people person" with good networking skills and contacts in the community.
- Good writing skills.

Training and Support Provided: 1 hour initial meeting with Program Coordinator to discuss ideas, trade contacts and conceptualize how program can be effective. Monthly meeting/phone-call with Program Coordinator for support and advice.

Length of Commitment: 6 months minimum. The time needed per program developed will vary greatly depending on the program.

Benefits: Seeing how ideas you have developed become full-fledged programs. Helping to build a better community by showcasing people's talents. Letting people know that the library is not only books and computers; it's a cultural and educational hub for Marin County.
