SUBJECT: Certification of Population Figures for 2022-2023

Section 18021 of the California Education Code specifies that the State Librarian must determine and certify on June 1 of each fiscal year the population served by each public library of the state based on census data compiled by the United States Department of Commerce or estimates prepared by the California Department of Finance, whichever is more current. For such purposes, no person shall be deemed to be served by more than one public library. The figures certified are for January 1, 2022 and based on the most recently published (May 2022) State of California, Department of Finance, Demographic Research Unit, [City/County Population estimates, with Annual Percentage Change, January 1, 2021 and 2022.](#)
